

Emergency Operations Center (EOC) CERT Internship

Understanding the Incident Command System is critical for a successful operation. The Incident Command System (ICS) is a standardized approach to the command, control, and coordination of emergency response providing a common hierarchy within which responders from multiple agencies may be effective.

The CERT EOC internship provides members the opportunity to experience Emergency Operations Management through tabletop exercises and EOC operations. Exercises help identify and practice EOC management and interoperability with Community partners.

The goal for interns is to gain first hand knowledge through experience and apply the ICS principles learned in required course work.

Course applicants must have a current Disaster Service Worker (DSW) Badge and be active within the CERT Program. Additionally, participation requires completion of the following FEMA online courses:

IS 100b "Introduction to the Incident Command System"

IS 200b "ICS for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents"

IS 315 "CERT Incident Command System"

Once accepted into the internship, participants will be offered EOC Management Training G775 "EOC Management and Operations and G191 "Incident Command System/Emergency Operations Center Interface" which will be available in early summer.

The Internship allows participation during EOC tabletop exercises initially acting as a scribe and sign-in and sign-out facilitators.
