In this workshop, which is designed for CERT Team Leaders and participants who have completed NIMS/SEMS ICS 100, 200 & 700, we will do a brief review of FRS Radio protocols and work through two plausible Mountain disaster scenarios. In the first scenario, we will walk through the process of:

- Setting up a local CERT Incident Command Post
- Develop an overall response strategy based on the directive received from the activating agency
- Safely and efficiently deploy teams and resources
- Document actions and results
- Hand over a concise summary to the activating agency when requested

6:15 – 7:15	Mountain Disaster Scenario #1 – Walk through scenario as a group
7:15 – 8:15	Mountain Disaster Scenario #2 – Table top exercise building on experience derived from Scenario #1
8:15 – 8:30	Debriefing on Scenarios #1 and #2
